AV requirements

We love bringing the house down with a great keynote, to help us do that we need some of the following:



Wireless lapel microphone for audiences larger than thirty people (an audio technician should be available prior to the presentation to ensure all in working order).

Cordless hand-held microphone available for audience interaction and questions.



Standard VGA connection and 3.5mm sound jack for connection to laptop for keynote presentation and computer sound.

We prefer to have a laptop on stage placed on a lectern to the side of stage.



Lighting - No one likes working in the dark so as much light on the stage and in the room as possible. Where data projection is being used, it may be required to have three locations on stage spotted - stage left, right and front centre.

Centered steps at the front of stage so that I can run out to the audience for some fun interaction.
